The company held a launching ceremony for the first shipment of frozen liquid pasteurized liquid whole egg from CP Foods' Ban Na egg processing plant in Nakhon Nayok Province to Japan.

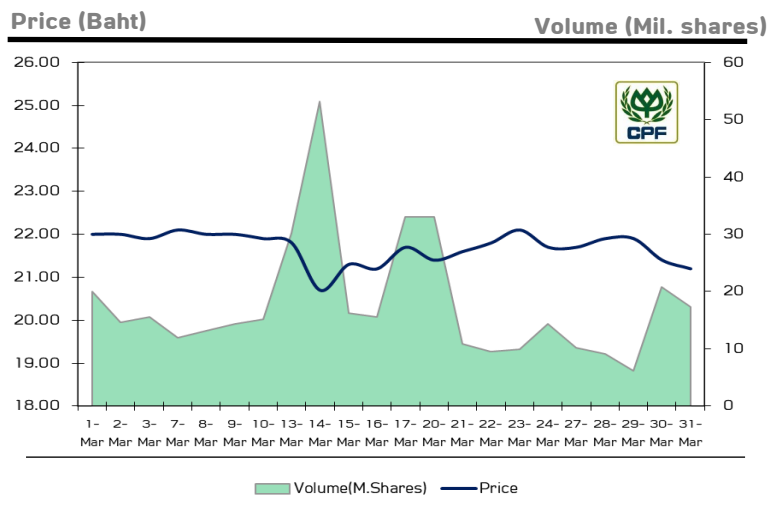
